**Molina Medicaid Solutions supports recovery
at Queen Louise Home for Children**

ST. CROIX – Executive Account Manager at Molina Medicaid Solutions, Luis Sylvester, delivered a \$1,000 contribution to Queen Louise Home for Children on Friday.

The donation will assist recovery efforts at Queen Louise Home. Mr. Sylvester credited the donation to Molina Medicaid honoring its policy to support and give back to the community. In 2016, Sylvester facilitated a collaboration between the company and New Balance shoes that brought new sneakers to every child at Queen Louise Home for the holiday season. With Queen Louise Home still recovering from the devastation of Hurricanes Irma and Maria, the gift could not have come at a better time.

“During the storm, the children wondered if things were going to happen, like Halloween and Christmas,” said Dana Holtz, director of Queen Louise Home. “We also needed to provide extra staff and adults to ease those fears so that we could mitigate any trauma. So a cash donation is so valuable to us right now to help alleviate those costs.”

Contributions to Queen Louise Home’s operational budget fund the costs of operating the program 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. Children first come to Queen Louise Home through the Department of Human Services (DHS) as a result of abuse, neglect, and displacement, or for respite care when needed. Queen Louise Home for Children is a program of Lutheran Social Services of the Virgin Islands —the largest private child and family services agency in the Virgin Islands.
